

Decree no. 7/2023
of the Rector of the Medical University of Gdańsk
dated 6 March 2023
concerning the organisation of the academic year 2023/2024

Pursuant to art. 23 sect. 1 and sect. 2 p. 2 of the *Higher Education and Science Act of Law* dated 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws 2022, it. 574), par. 23 sect. 1 and sect. 2 p. 2, par. 28 sect. 5 and par. 70 sec. 6 of the *MUG Statute* dated 3 June 2019 (namely, App. No. 1 to the Resolution 12/2022 of the MUG Senate dated 28 February 2022) in accordance with par. 4 of the *Rules of Study* that constitutes App. No. 1 to the Resolution 26/2022 of the MUG Senate dated 25 April 2022 concerning the introduction of the *Rules of Study*

it is now decreed, as follows:

§ 1

At the Medical University of Gdańsk the academic year 2023/2024 starts from 1 October 2023 and lasts to 30 September 2024 according to the following semester division:

Summer semester:	from 19.02.2024	to 30.09.2024
classes	from 19.02.2024	to 16.06.2024
Easter break	from 28.03.2024	to 03.04.2024
days free of classes	from 01.05.2024	to 03.05.2024
Summer examination session	from 17.06.2024	to 07.07.2024
Summer retake examination session	from 02.09.2024	to 15.09.2024
Dean's time limit for appeal	from 16.09.2024	to 30.09.2024

Note:

- *Academic classes in the summer semester for Pharmaceutical and cosmetic manufacturing and the 6th year of Medical studies [Polish and English Division] may last till 30 June 2024.
- On the day of the inauguration of the academic year 2023/2024, Rector's hours are planned.
- Orientation Week for 1st year students of English Division lasts from 25 September 2023 to 29 September 2023.
- Terms of the examination session do not pertain to the First Doctoral School and students who do their courses in the block system, and are obliged to take their examinations continuously (examinations are held immediately upon the completion of the relevant course block).
- During the academic year vocational practice in accordance with the study programme is obligatory.
- Examination session dates, semester and holiday breaks do not pertain to 6th year Master of Pharmacy students.

The following subdivision of the academic year pertains to part-time [extramural] students:

Division of the academic year for part-time students [extramural]		
Winter semester:	from 01.10.2023	to 18.02.2024
classes during Winter semester	from 01.10.2023	to 18.02.2024
Summer semester:	from 19.02.2024	to 30.09.2024
classes during summer semester	from 19.02.2024	to 30.07.2024
Part-time students have no semester break, or any strictly defined examination session. The examinations are held directly upon completion of the specific course. The retake examination session must end by 15 September 2024.
